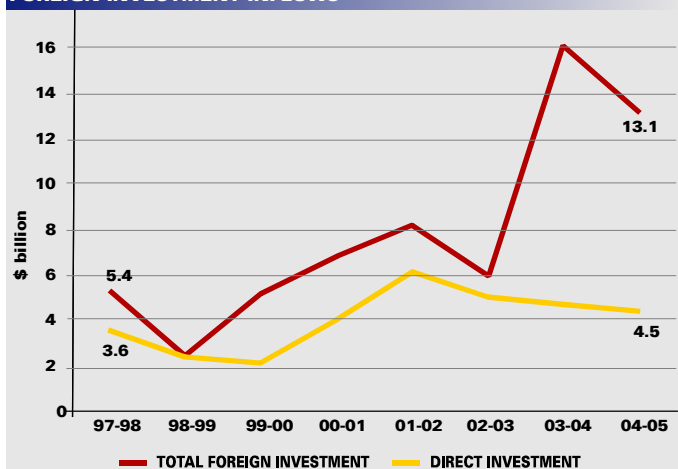

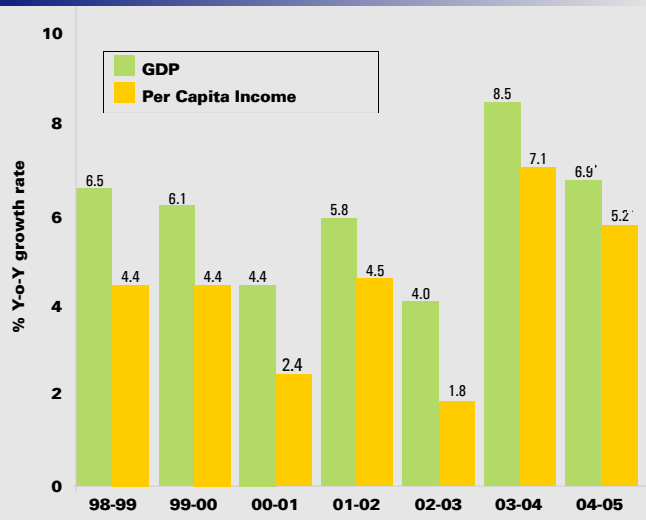

### GDP AND PER CAPITA GROWTH AT CONSTANT PRICES



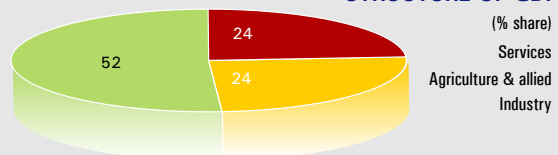

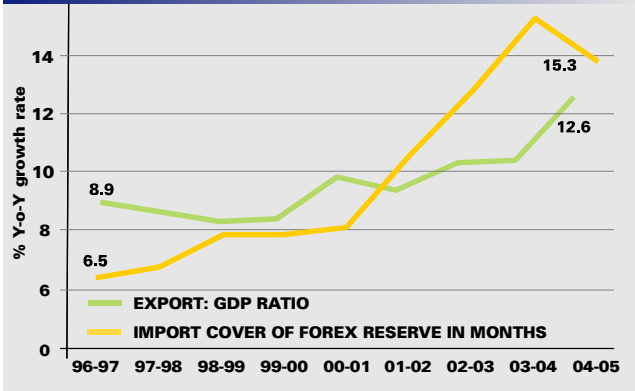

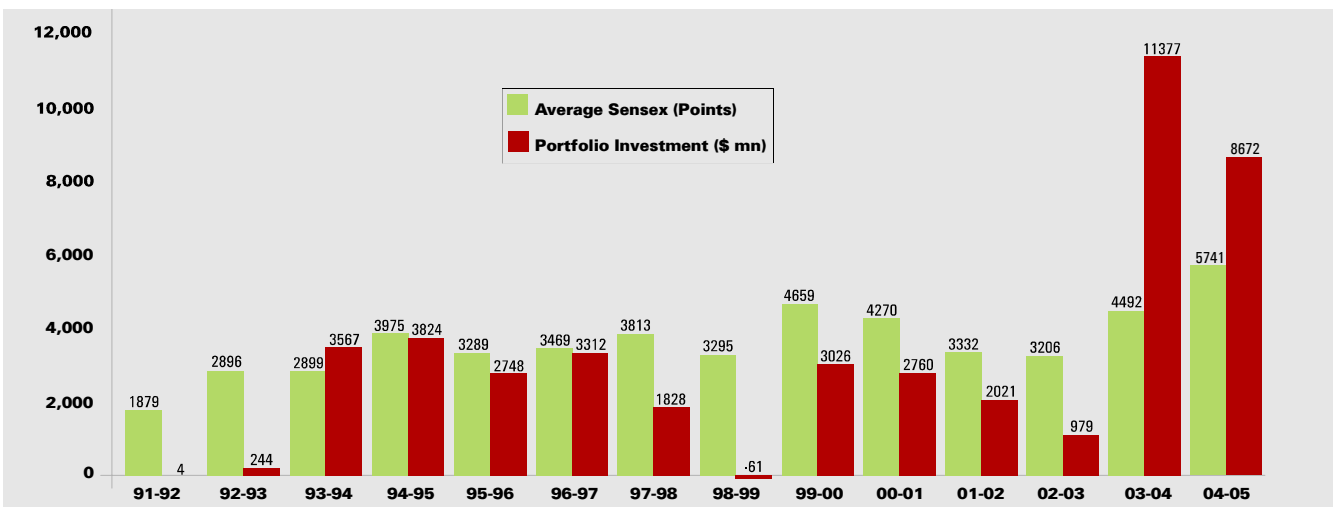
