*Indian specialists regularly perform super-sophisticated surgical procedures including cardio-thoracic, neurological and cancer surgeries, with success rates at par with global standards. The success rates in cardiac surgeries and renal transplants have been 98.5% and 95%, respectively.*

The Association of Surgeons of India (ASI) has been recognised as a designated society by the Surgeons Association of UK and Ireland and has now been retained to train surgeons from both these countries.

Surgical procedures in India cost 30-35% of what they cost in Europe and USA. According to Reuters, over 130,000 tourists visited India for various surgical procedures during 2005-06. Medical tourism is growing at 47% per annum.
