

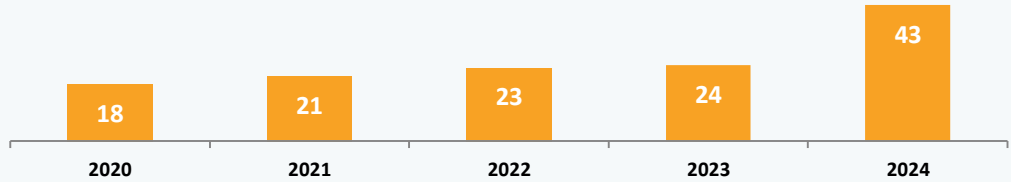

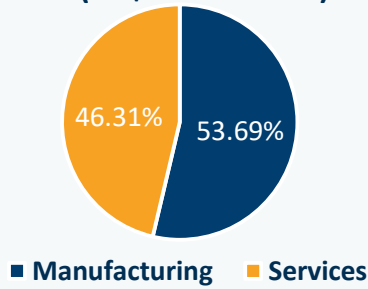

AYUSH Sector Growth Trend (US\$ billion)

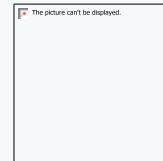


SECTOR COMPOSITION

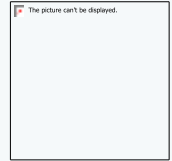
AYUSH Market in India (US\$ 43.4 billion)

The number of registered practitioners reached 7,51,768 in 2025

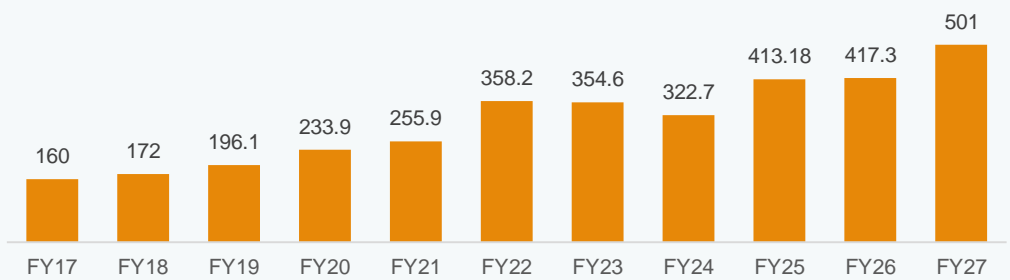


The number of Ayurveda colleges reached 563 (as of February 2026)

- Unmatched Legacy:** India is the birthplace of Ayurveda, Yoga & Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha, and Homeopathy, with a continuous practice tradition for millennia. A vibrant network of practitioners, educational institutions, and research centers keeps the AYUSH knowledge base alive and evolving.
- Growing Demand & Employment Opportunities:** Increasing public awareness of natural healthcare is driving demand for AYUSH products, fostering a dynamic market ripe for innovative businesses in the sector. Uttar Pradesh is expanding AYUSH with district-level 100-bed wellness centres, new colleges, and subsidies for medicinal crops to drive jobs, rural income, and health tourism.
- Favorable Regulatory Environment:** The Ministry of AYUSH drives research, education, and product standardization, fostering a conducive regulatory landscape for Ayurveda, Yoga, Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha, and Homeopathy (AYUSH) sectors. The Ministry of AYUSH's Union Budget allocation for FY27 has increased to Rs. 4,408.93 crore (US\$ 501.0 million), marking a 20.1% rise from the FY26 budget estimate of Rs. 3,671.82 crore (US\$ 417.3 million).
- Increasing Interest:** The number of MSMEs operating in the AYUSH sector has witnessed strong growth, increasing from 38,216 in August 2021 to 53,023 in January 2023, and further to 92,653 by August 2025. This sharp rise reflects accelerating formalisation, growing entrepreneurial activity and increasing market demand across the AYUSH ecosystem.
