




MARKET SIZE Registered MSMEs in India in FY24 (as of December 31, 2024)

- **Sector Overview**: As of May 2025, 6.44 crore MSMEs, with an employment of 26.77 crore are registered on Udyam Registration Portal and Udyam Assist Platform (UAP). The Union Ministry of Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises has received an allocation of Rs. 23,168 crore in FY26 Union Budget, reflecting a 4.6% increase compared to the FY25 Budget.
- Statutory Bodies: The MSME Ministry heads five statutory bodies—KVIC, Coir Board, NSIC, NI-MSME and the MGIRI. These bodies are responsible for aiding MSMEs with respect to government schemes and policies.
- Government Schemes: Under Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY), In FY25 Rs. 5,50,648 crore (US\$ 64.6 billion) was sanctioned under 5.07 crore Mudra loans to non-corporate and non-farm MSEs.
- Policy Support: The Union Budget for FY26 has raised the investment limits for MSMEs by 2.5 times and doubled the turnover thresholds.
