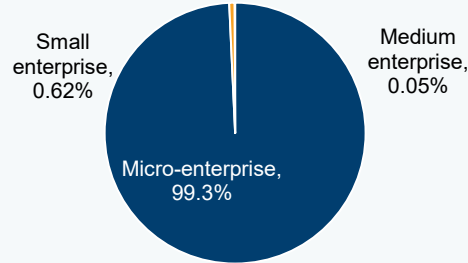

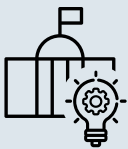

ADVANTAGE INDIA

- Sector Overview :** As of March 2026, over 7.9 crore enterprises were registered across both platforms, 4.72 crore on the Udyam Portal and 3.21 crore on the Udyam Assist Platform. This marks a significant milestone in MSME digitization.
- Statutory Bodies:** The MSME Ministry heads five statutory bodies - KVIC, Coir Board, NSIC, NI-MSME and the MGIRI. These bodies are responsible for aiding MSMEs with respect to government schemes and policies.
- Government Schemes:** The Government is promoting financial inclusion through the Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY). As of March 27, 2026, the scheme had sanctioned over 57.79 crore collateral-free loans worth Rs. 40.07 lakh crore (US\$ 453.39 billion), including Rs. 5.65 lakh crore (US\$ 63.93 billion) during FY26, to support non-corporate, non-farm income-generating activities.
- Policy Support:** The Ministry's budget allocation has shown a consistent upward trajectory over the last eight years, rising from Rs. 7.01 thousand crore (US\$ 0.92 billion) in FY20 to Rs. 24.56 thousand crore (US\$ 2.8 billion) in FY27.
