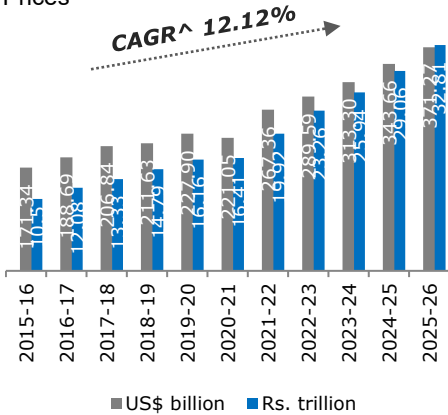




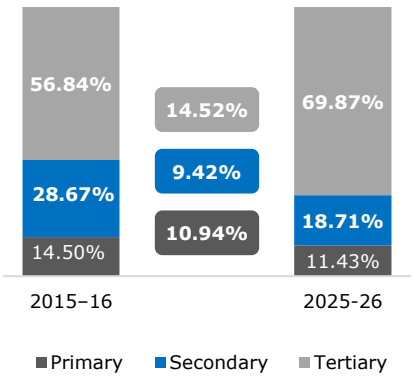

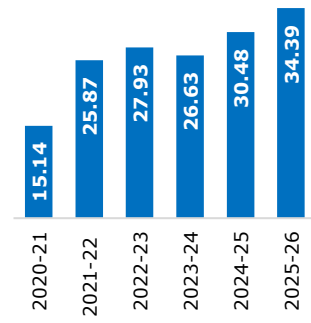
GSDP of Karnataka at Current Prices

Rich Talent Pool

Termed as the Knowledge Capital of India.
IT hub of India and the fourth-largest technology cluster in the world.



Significant Agriculture Base

According to the Karnataka Economic Survey 2025-26, Karnataka continued to be one of India's leading plantation crop-producing states, supported by strong production of coffee, coconut and other commercial crops.



Tourism

Karnataka boasts of diverse flora and fauna and 320 kms of natural coast-line.
World heritage sites at Hampi and Pattadakal.



Growing Exports

Total exports from the state stood at Rs. 3,03,642 crore (US\$ 34.39 billion) in FY26.
Engineering Goods were the top exported item from Karnataka, accounting for 27.9% of the total exports in FY26, followed by Electronic Goods at 27.6%.

National Education Policy 2020

In August 2021, Karnataka became the first state to announce the issue order to implement the National Education Policy 2020 from FY22 onwards.
