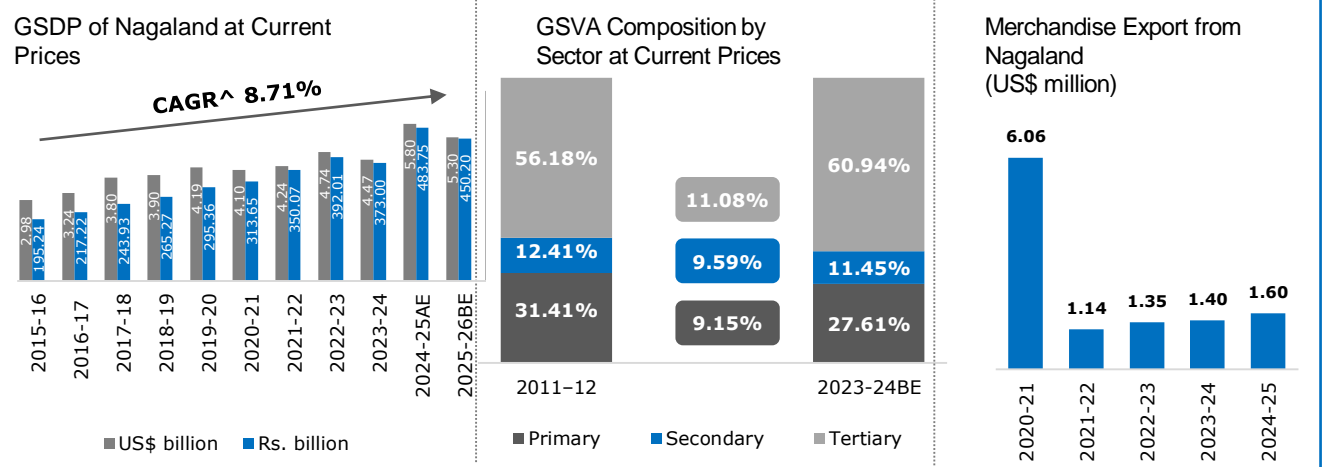

ADVANTAGES

Policy and infrastructure
The 'Nagaland: Enhancing Classroom Teaching and Resources Project' to impact ~150,000 students and ~20,000 teachers in the government education system in Nagaland.

Institutional support
The state provides institutional support through various central and state Government agencies viz., the North East Council, the Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region and the Nagaland Industrial Development Council.

Favourable location and abundant resources
Nagaland's agro-climatic conditions favour agriculture, horticulture and forestry, offering immense potential in these areas.

Availability of skilled labour
Nagaland has a high literacy rate of 79.55%. Most of the population in the state speaks English, which is the official language of the state.
The state strongly focuses on technical and medical education.

KEY GOVERNMENT POLICIES AND OBJECTIVES

Nagaland Road Maintenance Policy 2017
To ensure proper up-keep and maintenance of roads in the state.

Nagaland Food Processing Industries Policy (NFPIP), 2024
Policy to promote food processing, value addition, and agro-based industries to boost farmers' income and generate employment.

The State Budget 2025-26
In March 2024, the Nagaland Assembly passed a budget worth Rs. 23,727 crore (US\$ 2.84 billion) for FY25.

Harvest Educational Transformation Solutions (HETS)
In February 2021, the Harvest Educational Transformation Solutions (HETS) was launched in Dimapur to enhance education quality in Nagaland.

Nagaland Trade, Investment, and Industrial Policy (NTIIP), 2025
State's five-year policy to promote trade, attract investments, and support industrial growth.

GOVERNMENT VISION-2030 FOR THE STATE

Telecommunication
Create robust telecommunication infrastructure across the state with optical fibre utilising power transmission lines.

Agriculture
Nagaland could increase its annual agricultural production by seven to eight-fold by 2025.

Skillling the youth
High proportion of youth in the state's demography is a primary resource and is an opportunity to boost the economy.

Education
Digitisation of classrooms: E- classrooms and related ICT infrastructure for all schools by 2020-25.
