

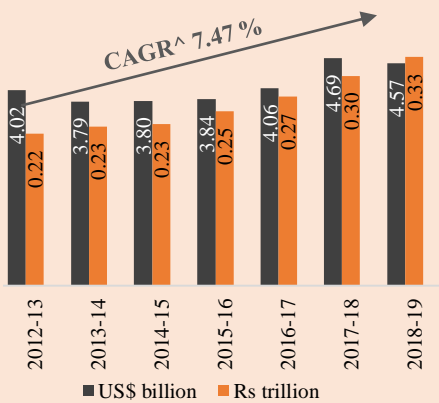

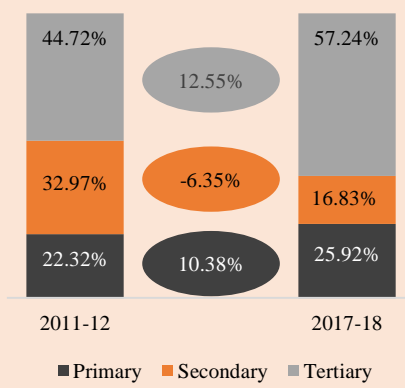

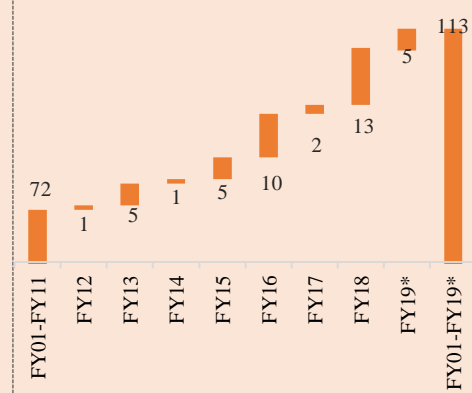
GSDP of Meghalaya at current prices

### Conducive agro-climatic conditions

### Policy and fiscal incentives

## Key Government Policies and Objectives

Meghalaya Road Maintenance Policy 2017

- Facilitates better approach in monitoring of road infrastructure in the state.

Meghalaya Industrial and Investment Promotion Policy 2016

- Facilitate investments in new sectors across the state and thus ensure accelerated and sustained growth

Water Act 2012

- Provide for water rights and obligations; conservation, control, management and use of water resources and supply

Meghalaya Mines and Minerals Policy 2012

- Facilitate systematic, scientific and planned utilisation of mineral resources and to streamline mineral-based development of the state.

Meghalaya Tourism Policy 2011

- Position Meghalaya as a preferred tourist destination by taking advantage of its rich cultural heritage and natural beauty.

IT Policy 2004

- Make information technology as a tool for attaining all round development in the state
